PROGRAM: Model Shooting Session: Models will be provided or shoot your spouse.

For the "Shooting Session" these suggestions are made. First, of course, is your camera, and a tripod is a very useful accessory. You may find a flash unit very useful, especially without a tripod. Flood lights will be furnished, so the choice of film will vary. With the floods, an indoor type of film should be used, or an outdoor film with a Blue 80A filter.

The higher speed ASA films will make faster shutter speeds and smaller lens openings possible. By using a fast shutter speed, a large lens opening and focusing directly on the subject, the result will make the model stand out from the backdrop.

The best lens for portrait photography is the 105 mm on the 35mm camera. This lens puts everything into its proper perspective. The standard 50mm lens should be the widest angle lens used.
