- To promote the advancement of photography as a hobby, science, and art

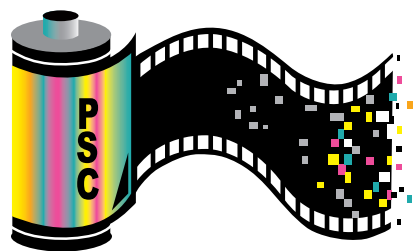
## **Program Meetings**

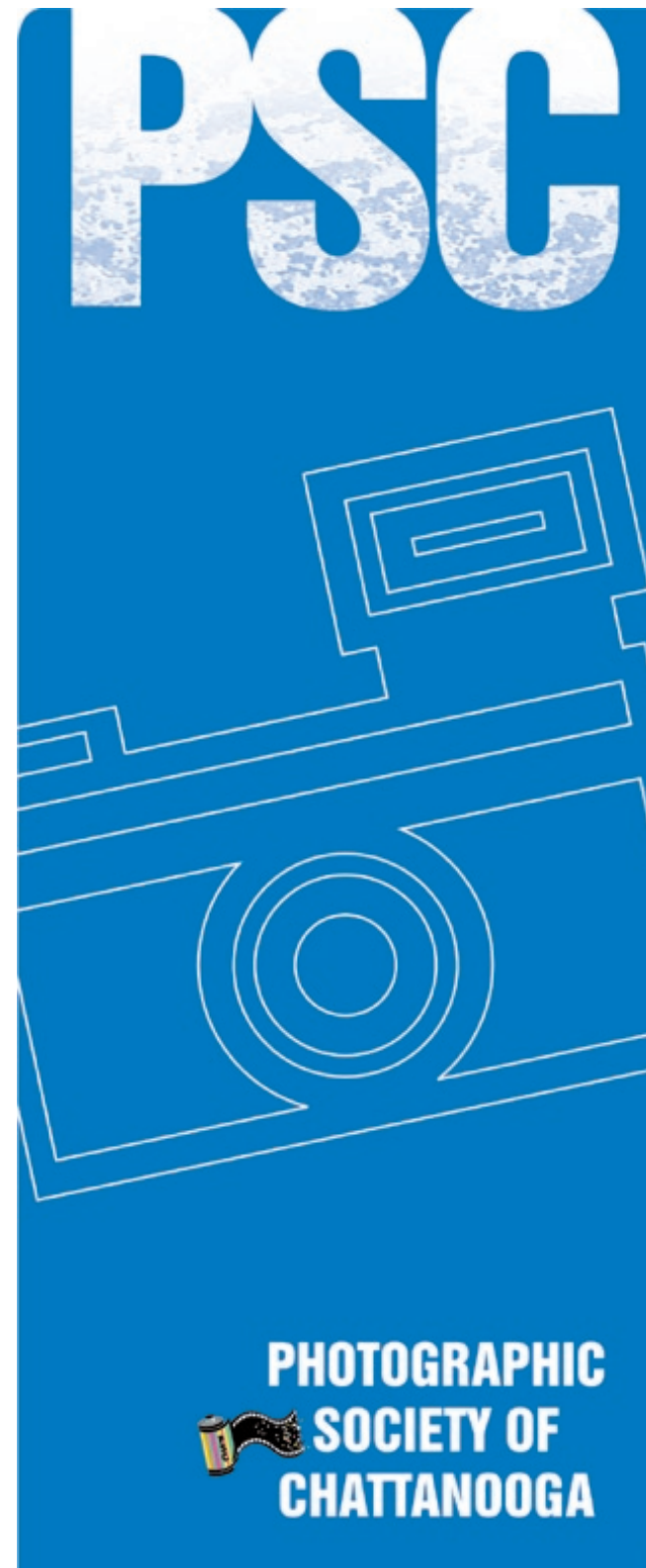
