Eligibility: SCIPE is open to anyone paying the entry fee and abiding by the Entry Rules except judges of the exhibition or their families. **Please read all the [Entry Rules](#) before entering the exhibition.** However, an entry may be rejected when the sponsoring organization or its agent, in its reasonable discretion, believes the entry does not conform to its exhibition rules and conditions.

Format: Digital Images Only - transmitted only by SCIPE Entry Form on the Internet – No CDs

- The files must be in JPEG format.
- Use the SRGB Color Space
- Maximum file size of 800 KB - If you submit files larger than 800 KB, you will receive an error message, and your images will be rejected.
- Maximum entry submission size of 8 MB - If the aggregate size of your files exceeds 8 MB, the submission will fail, and you will receive an error message.
- Maximum dimensions are 1024 on horizontal side and 768 on vertical side.

Fee: \$12 USD, for one section or for all 3 sections (4 images allowed per section) **Payment by PayPal only**
